Among his many accomplishments as a Law enforcement officer Bob innovated and implemented Operation Jeopardy, a program targeting at risk new gang members. During this time he also taught a Sunday School class, was a leader at Hume Lake Christian camps and participated in conferences, seminars and special church meetings all over the USA and worldwide. For the past 12 years Chief Vernon has led an international group in presenting courses on leadership, emphasizing ethics, to police and other governmental and private organizations.
